1) Qué son los condicionales y cómo elegir el tipo

Los condicionales unen una condición (if-clause) y un resultado (main clause). El tiempo verbal se elige según el tipo de realidad: hechos generales (0), futuro posible (1), hipótesis (2) o pasado imaginario (3).

Orden típico: If + condición, resultado. También puedes invertir el orden: resultado + if + condición.

2) Zero Conditional (0)

Uso: verdades generales, ciencia y rutinas. Estructura: If + Present Simple, Present Simple.

Ej.: If you heat water to 100°C, it boils.

3) First Conditional (1)

Uso: futuro realista/posible. Estructura: If + Present Simple, will + infinitive.

Ej.: If it rains, we'll stay at home.

Truco: normalmente no se usa 'will' en la if-clause (If it rains..., no 'If it will rain...').

4) Second Conditional (2)

Uso: hipótesis en presente/futuro (imaginario o poco probable). Estructura: If + Past Simple, would + infinitive.

Ej.: If I had more time, I would travel more.

Nota: con 'be', en registro formal se usa 'were': If I were you, ...

5) Third Conditional (3)

Uso: pasado imposible (arrepentimientos / 'qué habría pasado si'). Estructura: If + Past Perfect, would have + past participle.

Ej.: If we had left earlier, we would have caught the train.

6) Variantes frecuentes

- Modales en la consecuencia (can/may/might): If you study, you might pass.
- Imperativo: If you see John, tell him.
- Unless (= if not): Unless you hurry, you'll miss it.
- As long as / provided (that): I'll help as long as you ask politely.
- Mixed conditionals: If I had studied, I would be confident now.
